There are 465 students at our nursing school. They are from 15 to 19 years old.

Students are educated to become:

- **nurses** (a four year programme)
- **nursing assistants** (a three year programme).

During their studies they have a lot of practice work in school, the local hospital and nursing homes.











A NURSE

Students who finish the four year programme become nurses and they can get a job in:

- *health centres,*
- *hospitals,*
- *spas,*
- *social care institutions,*
- *educational institutions and*
- *anywhere else where health care is needed*





A NURSING ASSISTANT

Students who finish the three year programme become nursing assistants.

They are educated to work mainly in nursing homes to take care of elderly people. The care includes bathing, feeding and transporting people with health problems. They also obtain temperature, pulse and blood pressure.

Nursing assistants also help people who do not wish to go into a nursing home but need help in their own home.

They provide real companionship for old people who need their help.

AFTER SCHOOL ACTIVITIES

An important part of our programme are different after school activities where students can socialize, acquire knowledge in a different way and fulfill their personal needs and interests.

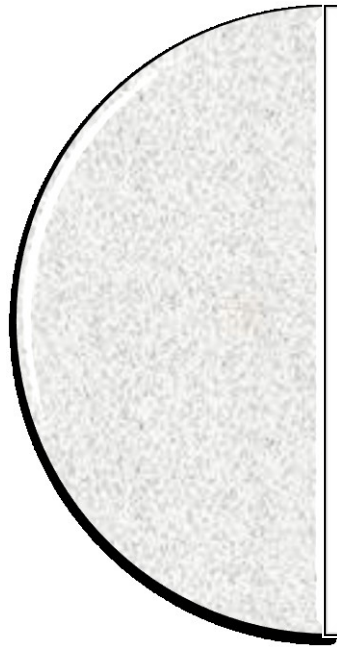

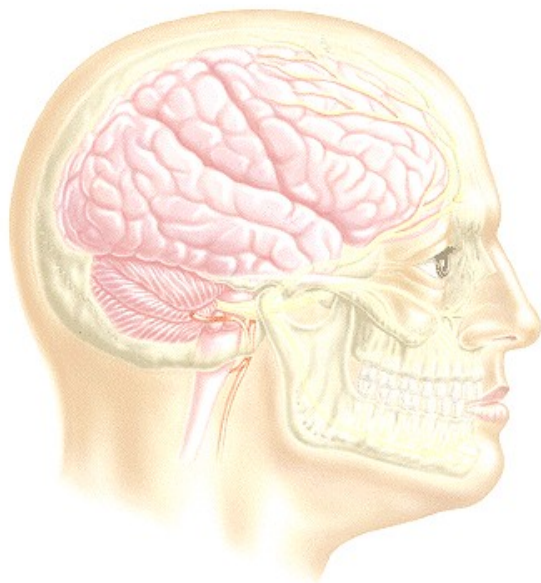
